



## Willow Bank Junior School - written statement of behaviour principles

- › Every pupil understands they have the right to feel safe, valued and respected, and to be able to learn free from the disruption of others
- › All pupils, staff and visitors are free from any form of discrimination
- › Staff and volunteers set an excellent example to pupils at all times
- › Pro-social behaviour is modelled, promoting pro-social experiences and feelings.
- › Pupils are helped to take responsibility for their actions and are supported to learn and re-direct anti-social behaviour through the consistent delivery of educational and protective consequences by staff, in line with the behaviour policy.
- › The behaviour policy is understood by pupils and staff
- › The exclusions policy explains that exclusions will only be used as a last resort, and outlines the processes involved in suspensions and exclusions
- › Families and carers are involved in the handling of behaviour incidents to foster good relationships between the school and pupils' home life

The governing board also emphasises that violence or threatening behaviour will not be tolerated in any circumstances.

This written statement of behaviour principles is reviewed and approved by Willow Bank Junior School Governing Body annually.
