

RULES:

- Start speech with a capital letter.
- “...” go around the phrase the character says.
- Use a reported clause to say who is speaking.
- Punctuation (! ? ,) goes before the final “.
- Start a new line when a new character speaks.
- If the reported clause comes before the speech, you will need a comma.
